

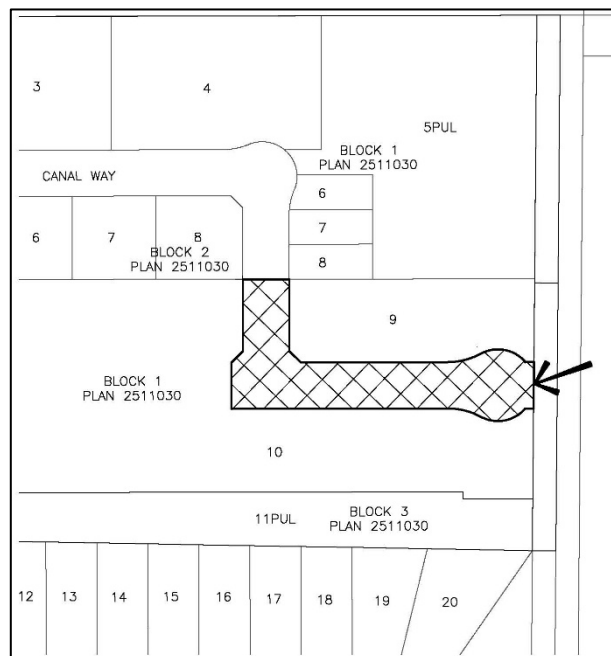
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

FOR PROPOSED BYLAW NO. 931-P-02-26 (ROAD CLOSURE)

APRIL 7, 2026 AT 5:00 P.M.
TOWN OF COALDALE COUNCIL CHAMBERS
(1801 20TH AVENUE, COALDALE, AB)

PURPOSE OF THE BYLAW: To close and dispose of, through consolidation with adjacent lots, those portions of road right-of-way that are legally described as:

PLAN 241 0242, THAT PORTION OF CANAL STREET AND CANAL WAY
 CONTAINED WITHIN PLAN 2511030 WHICH LIE WITHIN AREA A, ROAD
 CLOSURE PLAN 261_____,
 CONTAINING 0.355 HA (0.877 ACRES) MORE OR LESS
 EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS



EXPLANATORY NOTE: The road ROW in question will be resurveyed and registered slightly south of the current ROW location. This road closure process is a part of the steps required to shift the ROW to the south.
